
Check-in on the day of arrival after 14:00 (2 pm), check-out on the day of departure by 12:00 (noon).

General Information



The **VISA** regime used by the Republic of Slovenia forms part of the Union acquis (**Schengen visa**). It comprises two categories of countries: countries whose nationals must have a visa to enter the Republic of Slovenia and countries whose nationals do not need a visa.

GETTING TO LJUBLJANA BY AIR

Ljubljana Jože Pučnik Airport (LJU) is located 26 km northwest of Ljubljana (30 minutes by road).

Another airport with many international connections is **Airport Zagreb** (**ZAG**), **Croatia**, about 150 km southeast of Ljubljana.

GETTING TO LJUBLJANA BY ROAD

Ljubljana is located at the crossroads of Slovenia's most important road routes. Motorway access is very easy.

Road tax vignettes

Road tax vignettes must be purchased for the use of Slovenian motorways, including the Ljubljana bypass. Vignettes can be purchased at petrol stations or <u>online</u> (registration required).






CLIMATE

Typically, May in Ljubljana includes pleasant temperatures and high rainfall.

Expect the temperatures during the day to hover around 24°C (75°F). At night, they will likely drop to just above 10°C (50°F).



CURRENCY

The Slovenian currency is the **Euro** (€). Most stores accept international credit and payment cards. There is also a wide network of ATMs where you can withdraw cash.

ELECTRICITY - SOCKETS & PLUGS

For Slovenia there are two associated plug types, types C and F. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins and plug type F is the plug which





has two round pins with two earth clips on the side. Slovenia operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.
